Roseland Board of Education Highlights from Thursday, January 21st Board of Education Meeting

The Board congratulated and proudly recognized JoAnn Brady and Amy Dahn as Governor's Educators of the Year.

Ms. Gross provided an update on completion of District Goals which included

- improving reading scores;
- progressive professional development; and
- enhanced community outreach

Ms. Gross also provided an <u>HIB report</u> for September 2015 through January 2016, which revealed no HIB behavior patterns at Noecker.

Mr. Bohm provided an update on

- appropriate use of Title I Funds (for professional development);
- Capital Projects (repaving the parking lot); and
- Budget Calendar Outline.

In the President's Report, Mrs. Gordon gave an overview of Board roles and functions. She also provided an update on the following:

- Governor's Assessment Study Commission recommended continuation of administering PARCC in NJ;
