## • Grades 3 & 4 Daily - Synchronous (Onsite)

- Literacy, Mathematics, SS/Sci (alternates)
- Gym ONE DAY A WEEK alternates for A and B
- Technology ONE DAY A WEEK alternates for A and B



- Grades 3 & 4 Asynchronous (Remote)
  - 80 minutes of literacy a combination of reading logs & assignments, writing assignments, word work, Achieve 3000/Raz Plus, teacher pre-recorded lessons, and small group instruction in the afternoons, BSI
  - 80 minutes of math a combination of extension assignments related to previous day's concepts, IXL, teacher pre-recorded lessons, and small group instruction in the afternoons, BSI.
  - 40 minutes Science or Social Studies continuation of projects, including reading, observing, or journaling
  - 40 minutes Special area (library media, world language, art, music, PE (pre-recorded), health\*) - LIVE instruction; \*health is every other Friday for the offsite group- cohorting!
  - G&T, BSI, Related Services also on REMOTE DAY, where possible
