2530 <u>RESOURCE MATERIALS</u>

It is the policy of the Board to provide resource materials that will enrich and support the curriculum and provide the information and insights that will enable students to make intelligent judgments. Such materials should, so far as is possible, represent opposing sides of controversial issues so that students may develop the practice of critical reading and thinking; they should also represent diverse religious, ethnic and cultural groups and demonstrate the contributions of each to our society.

Selection of resource materials should take into consideration the varied interests, abilities and maturity levels of the students for whom they are intended, as well as the sensibilities and values of the community. The Superintendent shall devise procedures for their selection, which insure the participation of staff members and, as appropriate, students. Such procedures shall provide that the material selected shall be accurate, of permanent or timely value, authoritative, and' presented in such a manner as to be attractive to the student.
